Rules & Regulations

#1

Each candidate will have 4 minutes to introduce themselves and comment on some of the important areas of their platform. The order of speaking has been determined by drawing names from a hat.

#2

The time keeper will keep track on the stop watch and will sound the bell once when the speaker has 30 seconds left to speak and the bell will ring twice when time is up. We ask each candidate to adhere to the time limits in order to give everyone equal opportunity to speak.

#3

Once each candidate has spoken, we will begin addressing the questions that were submitted in advance as well as address the questions that are coming in live to the email address, skforum@lloydminsterchamber.com. We ask that your questions be specific and addressed to a particular candidate. We will not read a long preamble to a question, so in order to have questions addressed, they must be concise and to the point.

#4

Candidates will be given 2 minutes to respond to the questions. These will be timed as well with the bell ringing once at the 1.5 minute mark and twice when time is up.

#5

1 minute will be permitted for rebuttals with the bell only ringing twice when time is up.

#6

The moderator will rule out-of-order any question deemed inappropriate, offensive and derogatory or, that would seem to attack the integrity of any candidate.

#7

The moderator will have final jurisdiction in all matters. The moderator of the forum will be John Winter, member of the Chamber Political Action Committee.

#8

Candidates will be given 3 minutes for a wrap up. The order of speakers will be the reverse of the introductions.
